TOQUERVILLE CITY ANIMAL ORDINANCE #11-09-06

Amendment to: CITY ANIMAL ORDINANCE #.02-09-06

WHEREAS, The Toquerville City Council has determined a need to clarify a portion of the Toquerville City Animal Ordinance #02-09-06; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified SECTION 13.203, Care and Keeping of Animals; Keeping of Livestock, as the portion to be amended and adopted as provided herein;

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Toquerville, Utah, that the AMENDED SECTION 13.203, Care and Keeping of Animals, be adopted and made part of Toquerville City Animal Ordinance #11-09-06.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Toquerville City Ordinance #11-09-06, as Amended, shall repeal and supercede all prior Ordinances and Resolutions governing Animal Control in the City including without limitation, Ordinances #02-09-06, #01-09-03, and Ordinance #04-08-97.

SECTION: 13.203, SUBSECTION 13.203.01, Article C. is Amended to Read as Follows:

The keeping of livestock shall be a Permitted Use in Agricultural Zone (A).
The keeping of livestock shall be a Conditional Use in Zones designated R-1-20 and R-1-12, Single Family Residential.

For the keeping of livestock in the R-1-20 and R-1-12 Zones, a Conditional Use Permit, with payment of required fees, must be reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission; City Council review of Permits may be requested by Planning Commission; and Permits may be reviewed annually for Code Compliance.

The keeping of livestock shall also be limited to the following provisions:

<u>Animal</u>	<u>*Minimum Square Feet</u>	<u>Square Feet per Animal</u>
Horse	10,000	5,000
Mule	10,000	5,000
Donkey	10,000	5,000
Cow	10,000	5,000
Sheep / Goat	10,000	5,000
Llama	10,000	5,000
Chicken / Duck	500	25
Turkey / Goose	1,000	50

* Minimum Square Feet is the amount of land dedicated solely to the use.

1. Maximum of 50 small animals in cages or hutches, such as rabbits and quail.
2. These numbers do not include animals younger than (6) months.
3. Adequate containment must be provided for all animals.
